James 2:14-17

"What good is it, my brothers, if someone says he has faith but does not have works? Can that faith save him? If a brother or sister is poorly clothed and lacking in daily food, and one of you says to them, "Go in peace, be warmed and filled," without giving them the things needed for the body, what good is that? So also faith by itself, if it does not have works, is dead."

Ezra 10:4

Next, what has God called you to do? What is it He wants you to address? It could be anything from planning to teach the Life Equip Global training to others, perhaps to your Church or in a small group, or equipping men to resist sexual temptation, or how to encourage men to be better spiritual leaders, or how to offer healing to women who have abortions, rape or sexual abuse in their past. Or it could be something like starting a Pregnancy Ministry.

From whom do you need permission? List all those who need to be involved to make the plan a success. What resources are needed? Where will it take place? When will the plan get started?
