

Pregnancy Center Field Life Advocate

Individuals who volunteer in a local Pregnancy Center who are trained to offer hope, education, and the Gospel to women considering abortion are usually called Client Advocates. Clients is the name for a person who has entered the Pregnancy Ministry or Center and - after having filled out necessary paperwork - have been accepted as a client.

Individuals who are affiliated with a local Pregnancy Center and have read, studied and learned the material found in the www.lifeequipglobal.org website and are using HopeSync to share hope, education and the Gospel **outside** of the Pregnancy Center are called a Pregnancy Center Field Life Advocate.

A Pregnancy Center Field Life Advocate is equipped and prepared - using HopeSync Global - to assist anyone who is considering or has questions about abortion.

A Pregnancy Center Field Life Advocate may not be able to work as a Client Advocate in a Pregnancy Center for a variety of reasons including age, work or school duties. A Pregnancy Center Field Advocate receives initial and on-going training and direction at their local Pregnancy Center using HopeSync and other CPC training.

A Pregnancy Center Field Advocate works under the guidance and direction of their local Pregnancy Center.
