A Pregnancy Center in a Medical facility will usually have a leadership team, consisting of a Center Director and - depending on the size of the ministry and the number of clients they minister to - additional staff. In this scenario medical staff may not be necessary if medical services are being provided by the Medical facility.

In addition to a leadership team or staff, Pregnancy Centers of this type may engage the use of volunteers to assist in a variety of ways. This includes assisting with administrative functions and ministering to clients.

Pregnancy Centers serve women who are pregnant - one of the services offered is a pregnancy test - with hope, education and encouragement to assist the woman in making a life-affirming, life-saving decision. Some Medical Pregnancy Centers offer services both to women and men. Some services are provided free of charge while others are provided on a fee for services provided basis.

Services provided by Medical Pregnancy Centers may include:
